## About Spay Virginia

---

Spay Virginia is a project of the Virginia Federation of Humane Societies (VFHS). Through Spay Virginia, VFHS was instrumental in establishing three low cost, high volume spay/neuter clinics in Virginia: the Margaret B. Mitchell Spay/Neuter Clinic, the Shenandoah Valley Spay/Neuter Clinic, and the South Central Spay/Neuter Clinic. Initially owned by VFHS, each of these businesses is now an independent organization serving its community.

In 2009, VFHS expanded the Spay Virginia project by launching a new Spay Virginia website and statewide toll-free hotline. The Spay Virginia website contains a searchable database, by county or city, of low cost spay/neuter offerings throughout Virginia, including high volume spay/neuter clinics and local referral and subsidy programs offered by humane societies.

Through our hotline, staffed by a live operator 20 hours per week, we are able to assist pet owners across Virginia in locating low cost spay/neuter services. Our goal is to be able to provide low cost options for each and every person in need who is seeking to spay or neuter his or her pet.
